



DECLARATION OF COLORADO RESIDENCY

Every production company seeking to claim a portion of the Colorado Film Incentive Rebate must present proof that at least 25% of their employees are Colorado residents and lawfully working in the United States. Each production company shall maintain records for a period of 24 months that establish an employee's proof of residency and legal immigration.

Colorado Residency Requirements

To be considered a Colorado resident you must maintain your primary residence in the State of Colorado. Your primary residence is defined as your permanent home. It is the place you intend to return to after any temporary absence. In order to establish proof of residence you must possess a Colorado driver's license, state issued identification card or a voter identification card issued by the State of Colorado. A copy of the appropriate document must be attached to this form.
